NOVEMBER... After a great first half term we are focusing on small group work this month and have started to introduce children to musical instruments. We are also having key groups in which children are with their key person and other children and they will do simple activities, have opportunities to focus on things that will further support your child such as listening and attention, communication and language etc. All children have now had a Wellcomm assessment and some of them speech sounds checks to identify aspects of both receptive and expressive language that may need additional support.

Extra Sessions...Before Christmas I will be looking to see if we can accommodate any extra sessions for children on a permanent basis, starting from January 2025. We will then be able to establish if we can offer any more children a place from our waiting list. Some days are fuller than others but we will see what we can do so if you are interested in further sessions please let me know before Friday 29th December. I can't guarantee we will be able to offer everything you want as we may need to recruit, so even if you have spoken to me already,

please can you email me upon return with requests. Some of you will be entitled to the 30 hours from January so I need to see what we are able to accommodate. Recruitment is still very difficult in the early years sector.

Applying for a school place for September 2025... Applications can now be submitted for children to join Reception at Primary School for 2025/26.

The deadline for receipt of completed applications is <u>15 January 2025</u> and National Offer day is <u>16</u> <u>April 2025</u>

Applications received after the deadline will be processed later in the year and are far less likely to secure a place at a preferred school.

If you have children who are summer born (1 April – 31 August) but wish to delay entry to primary school (September 2026) then you need to complete a separate form via the website <u>Delay reception application | Oxfordshire County Council</u> They will need to formally consult with the school(s) to check if they are in agreement and we encourage them to still apply through the usual way for entry in 2025, until the request has been dealt with.
